17% of the outback population are from indigenous

Nearly 17% of the total population is made up of people from the indigenous Aboriginal tribes. As of 2006, the Outback has a total population of less than 700,000 residents.

Uluru is taller than the Eiffel Tower!

Uluru stands 348 metres tall, higher than the Eiffel tower at 324 metres, the Great Pyramid at 139m & the Statue of Liberty at a piffling 93m.

The Outback has the longest straight road!

National Highway 1 linking Western Australia and South Australia has the world's longest stretch of straight bitumen road, 146.6 kms without a bend. The Outback has the only known fossilised dinosaur stampede in the world!

Thousands of footprints are preserved in mudstone near Lark Quarry Conservation Park. The footprints have been interpreted as 150 two legged dinosaurs escaping a much larger predator!
