Bob said, "You know, I bet he'll jump." The blonde replied, "Well, I bet \$20 he won't."


Bob placed a \$20 bill on the bar and said, "You're on!"


Just as the blonde placed her money on the bar, the guy on the ledge did a swan dive off the building.


The blonde was very upset, but willingly handed her \$20 to Bob. "Fair's fair. Here's your money."
