It's great to see how everyone is diving in to help the children are eager to learn and to help.

Found good service so a quick update on my end. Church yesterday was very good but also very different compared to what we do in Australia.

Good day of resting and James got the solar connect so we can now charge, up things are easier now (thank you James).

Had a good game of soccer yesterday afternoon the kids loved the new soccer ball that was brought. We were playing with a flat ball that had a big hole in it and when the new one came down, we went straight out to the big field to play, and boy did this highlight how unfit I am.

Yesterday we celebrated James birthday. With plenty of singing, dancing and Cake. After yesterday concreting we have completed 7 of the 8 portions of concreting for the dining hall. The last portion will be completed by those we have trained.

James has also cut all the window and door holes so now it is only the fixing and plastering of them into place. Dave has also connected most of the new taps and repaired the old tank for irrigation of the vegetable garden. Caleb is still struggling with his health so continue to pray for him. It is very hot but thankfully it cools off a bit at night.
